LAHC Vice President to Speak on Women in Leadership; May 19, 2010



On May 19, 2010, LAHC Vice President, Suehaila Amen will speak at a conference on Women in Leadership to be hosted by the Human Resource Development (HRD) at the University of Michigan-Ann Arbor; an organization charged with bringing training to university staff and faculty.

The all day event will feature Betsy Myers, senior advisor to Barack Obama's presidential campaign and former executive director of the Center for Public Leadership at Harvard's Kennedy School of Government. She will be speaking on *authentic leadership*, the topic of her forthcoming book, and *women in leadership*. In addition to Betsy's keynote presentations, there are two panel discussions – one on women in leadership and one on leading in lean times.

Amen will present on the panel for Women in Leadership and will discuss the involvement of women in grassroots leadership, leading efforts within a minority community and mobilizing women to play a more active role, civically and socially.
